### **#1. Internship Program:**

An ongoing internship program provides training and opportunities to learn each aspect of the broadcasting field. During the applicable period, one (1) non paid/college credit only intern participated in this program. The Radio station disseminated information on this program to all area Colleges, and through the SUNY system. We received one response to the internship request, interviewed 1 intern for interest, and qualifications and granted one internships, during 2009. A general internship agenda and program was established for the participant, and at the completion of the program a certificate of completion was awarded.

### **#2. New York State Broadcasters Association - Nelson Rockefeller Internships**

WGNY-AM/FM participated in the NYSBA Internship program in 2009. During the applicable period, 1 paid internship was awarded to a Full-time college student. The Radio station disseminated information on this program to all area Colleges, and through the SUNY system. A general internship agenda and program was established for the student , and at the completion of the program a certificate of completion was awarded.

### **#3. Job Fairs:**

Participation in Local EXPOS/Career Events- WGNY personnel throughout the report period attended and participated in various events including the OCCC and the Mount St. Mary Colleges Career Days.

### **#4. Radio Station Open Houses:**

On March 14, 2009, WGNY held an open house inviting anyone interested to an Open House at our Main Studio. We discussed the industry and employment opportunities with those who attended and invited anyone interested to check with us for future employment opportunities.

### **#5. Tours:**

WGNY personnel throughout the report period promoted and conducted various events, both inside the radio station consisting of tours to area students and their parents, to educate and disseminate information regarding employment.
